

## The government imposes stricter restrictions

**The Corona infection is increasing in Europe. In Sweden, the government puts even stricter rules.**

The infection is increasing in Europe, and also in Sweden. To make it possible for those who work in healthcare to take care of the most ill, we must all continue not to spread the infection.

”The situation continues to be very serious. The spread of the infection is high, and [...] the staff in elderly care and health care, work around the clock”, Prime Minister Stefan Löfven said earlier.

To be clear with what everyone has to do, even stricter rules will now be implemented.

-It must not be crowded in shops and shopping malls. Those who have shops or own a shopping mall have to investigate how many people can be there at the same time, in a safe way. They also have to arrange to make sure the amount of people is not exceeded.

Between Christmas Eve and New Year’s Eve the shops usually arrange a mid-day sale. This year all stores are urged not to arrange any mid-day sale.

The upper secondary schools must have distance education until January 24.

Only four people can sit at the same table at a restaurant. No alcohol may be sold in restaurants after 20.00 (From December 24)

Everyone who can work from home has to do that.

-You must wear face mask when going by bus or train. This applies in weekdays from 7 January. If you don’t have your own mask, there will be

masks at the train or bus. The rules are the same in cities as in the countryside.

### Face mask when it is crowded on buses or trains

It can not be proven whether face masks in the public prevents infection.

In several countries where you have to wear mask, the infection still spreads.

The most important and most effective way to prevent infection is to keep your distance. But where this is not possible, face mask can play a certain role”, says Johan Carlsson, head of the Public Health Agency.

After the holidays, on January 7, many children start school again and many adults go back to work. It can cause congestion on some trains or buses.

### Ask the school or municipality if you need to know what’s opened or closed

All municipalities have closed their libraries, museums, bathhouses, sports halls and open preschools,

In some municipalities other activities can also be closed.

Always ask the school or municipality if you are unsure of what is open.
