# Co-operation Agreement

In the light of the co-operation between the Lake Victoria region and the Baltic Sea region, Uganda and Sweden as well as the existing good relations between the cities Entebbe and Kalmar the cities have established the following co-operation agreement.

## Article No. 1

The two cities should promote the co-operation between different municipal administrations, associations, organizations, companies and individual citizens. The aim is to contribute to a positive and sustainable development (ecological, social and economic) for the cities and its citizens. The co-operation can be organized as direct contact through study visits and participating in projects but also through written exchange of experiences and reports.

## Article No. 2

In the first place the co-operation should be concentrated on the following areas:

- Physical planning and environmental protection
- Education and school contacts
- Culture exchange
- Exchange between women's networks
- Exchange with regard to improve knowledge and understanding
- Tourism

## Article No. 3

To evaluate the result of the co-operation and to discuss the future co-operation the parties should organize delegation meetings at least every third year, alternately in Uganda and in Sweden.

## Article No. 4

To realize the co-operation the parties should apply for external financial support for the joint projects.

## Article No. 5

The co-operation according to this agreement should be effected in accordance with the legislation of the two countries. The co-operation agreement can be cancelled by a special agreement between the parties.

## Article No. 6

The agreement will come into force when the decision-making bodies of the two cities have approved the agreement.
